Glasson of Barassi, Curl & Abraham, P.L.C.) - PERSONAL INJURY - PEDESTRIAN/PICKUP TRUCK - PARKING LOT MISHAP. Plntf, female, alleged that, while walking in a parking lot, she was struck by Dfnt, who was operating a 2001 Chevrolet pickup truck. Dfnt, male, denied liability. Plntf alleged she sustained an injury to the left knee, which required surgical repair. Plntf called John A. Meaney, M.D., an orthopod. Dfnt used the deposition of Edward J. Berghausen, M.D., an orthopod. Dfnt argued Plntf's complaints were unrelated. Prayer: Just and reasonable compensatory damages; plus over \$12,000 medical expenses. (Carrier: State Farm Insurance.) Two day trial. By stipulation, four jurors deliberated. Jury out one-plus hours. FOUND FOR DFNT. UNANIMOUSLY.
